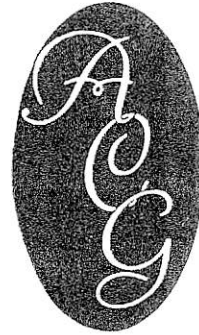


Our Mission

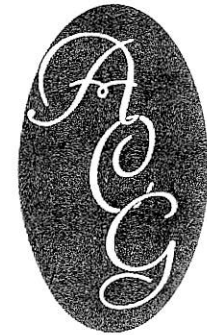
